APPLYING TO AN ONTARIO POST-SECONDARY PROGRAM

Applying to a Post-Secondary Program involves **TWO MAJOR STEPS**:

STEP 1: **RESEARCHING** programs and checking if you meet the **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS** of those programs that you want to apply to

STEP 2: Completing the **ONLINE APPLICATION**

APPLYING TO UNIVERSITY

In order to apply to a **University Degree Program** you must:

- ❑ Obtain your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (graduate) by the end of the school year
- ❑ Obtain a minimum of 6 Grade 12 University (4U) or University/College (4M) credits
- ❑ Meet the specific requirements of the program that you are interested in

APPLYING TO COLLEGE

In order to apply to a **College Diploma Program** you must:

- ❑ Obtain your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (graduate) by the end of the school year
- ❑ Meet the specific requirements of the program that you are interested in
- ❑ The highly competitive (popular) programs usually have additional requirements

In order to apply to a **College Degree Program** you must:

- ❑ Obtain your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (graduate) by the end of the school year
- ❑ Obtain a minimum of 6 Grade 12 University (4U) or University/College (4M) credits
- ❑ Meet the specific requirements of the program that you are interested in

STEP 2: ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESS

- ❑ Applications to all the Ontario Universities and Colleges are completed **ONLINE**.
- ❑ University applications are completed on the OUAC website.
- ❑ College applications are completed on the OCAS website.

APPLYING TO A SCHOOL OUTSIDE OF ONTARIO

- ❑ If you are interested in applying to a school outside of Ontario, the best thing to do is to check out that school's website for specific application information. In many cases, you can apply directly to the school or through the Common App (<https://www.commonapp.org/>)
- ❑ If you are applying to an **American School** you most likely have to complete the **SAT** (www.collegeboard.com) or **ACT** (<https://www.act.org/>)
