Principals Report - February 26, 2025

- 1. SHSM Creating Pathways to Success
 - Board has hired 3 people to support schools with SHSM ensuring experiential learning opportunities are available for students
 - Working to build and continue to develop community partnerships in the following sectors: (1) Arts and Culture, (2) Business, (3) Construction new this year, (4) Health and Wellness, (5) Hospitality and Tourism, (6) Information and Communications Technology, (7) Non-Profit
 - Skills Competition is underway with students participating in culinary, graphic design, robotics, construction
 - First time Grade 10 Careers/Civics students will have an opportunity to attend the skills competition on March 4 at the Seaway Mall to learn about skilled trades and pathways available to them
- 2. Open House
 - January 16, 2025
 - Excited to welcome parents from associate schools
 - Very successful night
 - Positive comments from parents/guardians how respectful and helpful all students were, how pleasant the teachers were
- 3. Website
 - Moving to a new provider for all websites in NCDSB School Messenger will be the provider, will have a uniformed look across all schools
 - Our website will change over approximately March Break
- 4. School Improvement
 - OSSLT fall session ran successfully approximately 88% success rate, based on our numbers for first time eligible students
 - Grade 9 EQAO 63% students achieving level 3 and 4, no failures
 - Math focus for this year in on balanced assessment ensuring there are knowledge and understanding, communication, application, and thinking questions this is also being implemented in all departments
 - Also have a problem of practice for math looking at the data of our incoming students and the discrepancy between Grade 6 EQAO and Grade 8 report card marks and what we are seeing students capable of in the classroom, as well as looking at Grade 9 data - often there is a large gap between marks - trying to determine the cause of the gaps

- Looking at exposing our students to tech more often in class to complete assessments - Knowledgehook or NCVLE to have students complete multiple choice questions - compare right vs wrong, but also have a separate mark for process - in literacy will begin to look at having students read not only in print but also using tech
- This allows for students to experience the same conditions for EQAO/OSSLT as they have in class
- 5. Transition
 - Student Services have been out at our family of schools working on course selection with our incoming Grade 8's
 - Working with FOS administration teams to ensure 100% retention rate
 - Will gather feedback from FOS to inform next year's plan with a focus on having students in the building more often and highlighting other sports and activities for students to participate in.
